

# CAJUN STUD

The object of the Game is for the player to achieve a poker hand that triggers a winning event against a payable. Cajun Stud also contains several optional bonus wagers.

## Ante and Play Wagers

Each player receives two hole cards, face down. Once all players receive their cards, the next four cards dealt are placed in the designated All Six card square. The dealer then receives three cards and places them face down in the designated community board area.

Each player will use the 3 community cards to form their own five card poker hands.

After examining their two hole cards, each player must then decide to do one of the following:

- a. Players may choose to place a Raise wager or fold. This raise wager must be 1x, 2x or 3x their original Ante wager. If a player folds, they surrender their Ante wager and the optional side wagers will be settled at the completion of the hand.
- b. The first community card will be revealed and players may choose to place a Raise wager or fold. This wager must be 1x, 2x or 3x their original Ante wager. If a player folds, they surrender their Ante and Raise Wagers and the optional side wagers will be settled at the completion of the hand.
- c. The second community card will be revealed and players may choose to place a Raise wager or fold. This wager must be 1x, 2x or 3x their original Ante wager. If a player folds, they surrender their Ante and Raise Wagers and the optional side wagers will be settled at the completion of the hand.
- d. The third community card will be revealed and the hands will be settled.

## Ante and Raise Paytable

Royal flush 500 to 1

Straight flush 100 to 1

Four-of-a-kind 40 to 1

Full house 10 to 1

Flush 6 to 1

Straight 4 to 1

Three-of-a-kind 3 to 1

Two Pair 2 to 1

Pair of Jacks or better 1 to 1

Pair of 6s to 10s Push

## Optional Bonus Wagers

Cajun Stud also contains several optional bonus wagers. The outcome of the primary wager has no effect on the bonus wagers, as a player may lose the primary wager(s), but still get paid on the bonus wagers. All Bonus wagers must be placed prior to the start of play.

## Lo Ball

The Lo Ball bet wins if the players five card hand evaluates to a Jack High or less:

### Lo Ball Paytable

7 High 100 to 1

8 High 50 to 1

9 High 15 to 1

10 High 5 to 1

Jack High 1 to 1

### Board Bonus

A player wins their Board Bonus wager if the three card hand formed by the three community cards consists of one of the winning triggering events:

### Board Bonus Paytable

Mini-royal 50 to 1

Straight flush 40 to 1

Three-of-a-kind 30 to 1

Straight 6 to 1

Flush 3 to 1

Pair 1 to 1

### Pocket Bonus

If the player's initial two card hand forms a Pair or an "Ace plus a Face" (AK, AQ or AJ) hand, the player wins their Pocket Bonus wager:

### Pocket Bonus Paytable

Pair of aces 30 to 1

Ace and a king, queen or jack of the same suit 20 to 1

Ace and a king, queen or jack of different suits 10 to 1

Pair of 2s—kings 4 to 1

### All-Six Bonus

A player wins their All-Six wager if their six-card hand, formed by combining the player's two-card hand with the four card All Six community hand, forms at least a Three-of-a-Kind:

### All Six Paytable

Royal flush 1,000 to 1

Straight flush 200 to 1

Four-of-a-kind 50 to 1

Full house 25 to 1

Flush 20 to 1

Straight 10 to 1

Three-of-a-kind 5 to 1

\$50,000 Maximum Payout per Player Per Hand.
