## TOURNAMENT

### TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- Tournament date is Saturday April 13, 2019 starting at 12PM.
- No buy in required. Entry into tournament will be by qualification or invitation.
- mychoice® Elite and Owners Club members, invited by their host, must be registered by April 1, 2019.
- All prizes will be paid in Cash or Chips by The Meadows Racetrack and Casino for a grand total of \$15,000.
- The tournament will consist of one main event.
- Guests can qualify for a free entry by reaching 1,500 in total mychoice tier points from March 1-31, 2019 by playing their favorite slots and table games.
- Guests will then swipe their card at the kiosk and print out an earned entry from April 1-13, 2019.
- Guests will take their printed entry from the kiosk and register at the cage for their seat and time with limited seating available. (First come, first served)
- Once the event is filled, there will be a waiting list available. Any guest that is on the waiting list will have to arrive prior to the first round of play and each subsequent round to be picked. We will fill in the order of the wait list.
- Seat assignments in all rounds will be randomly drawn and players may not change seats.
- Each tournament round will consist of a 30 minute open play window with a chip countdown at the end of 30 minutes. After the countdown, play will commence for 5 more minutes. Final score will be determined by the value of chips at the end of the round or the roll when an entrant has lost the last of their chips. If two entrants lose on the same roll, the amount of the line bet for the round will determine the place; the player who made the larger wager will place higher.
- The first shooter will be selected by a Supervisor roll of a die. Based on the point value of the die, the player in the corresponding position will roll first. If the position rolled is unoccupied, the die will be rolled again until an occupied position is rolled.
- In all rolls, a 1 minute betting window will be opened and bets may be made as in traditional craps play. At the end of the minute, no more bets will be accepted.
- If it becomes necessary in any round to break a tie, the round scores will be recorded and then three additional rolls will occur, and repeated (if necessary), until the tie is broken. No additional chips will be received for tie breakers.
- Prizes will be paid immediately following the conclusion of the final round. Prizes will be paid out of the main cage.
- In all rounds: players will receive \$10,000 in tournament chips with a minimum bet of \$100 and no maximum bet. Bets made on the betting areas must be proper bets.
- The minimum/maximum bet on the prop bets will be \$100 and must be proper. No fire bets, whirl bets, horn high, horn low, hop bets or opposing bets will be permitted during tournament play.
- All players must provide government-issued photo ID at check in. Any players banned from The Meadows Casino, PGCB excluded or PGCB self-excluded are not eligible to participate.
- A copy of the Craps Tournament Rules is available upon request.

### MAIN TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE

- 112 total entrants
- All value chips will be credited off the table prior to the start of the tournament.
- The Score for each round will be the total value of tournament chips at the end of the round.
- There will be 4 elimination rounds.
- Each tournament elimination round will consist of two tables with 14 players each. Each table will complete a total of 35 minutes of open play. Scores will be recorded on the tournament sheet for each round.
- 6 winners at each table and 4 wild card winners will advance to the semi-final, 28 people.
- 4 wild card winners will be drawn from all contestants who did not qualify for the semi-final. If a wild card winner is not present within 1 minute of their name being called another will be drawn until four wild card winners are found and the 28 player semi-final round is filled.
- Semi-final round will be dealt at 4PM. The semi-final will be two tables of 14 players each. Each table will complete a total of 35 minutes of open play. Seat assignments will be randomly drawn and players may not change seats. The top 6 players at each table will advance to the finals, 12 players.
- 2 wild card winners will be drawn from all contestants who did not qualify for the final table. If a wild card winner is not present within 1 minute of their name being called another will be drawn until two wild card winners are found and the 14 player final round is filled.

- Final round will be dealt at 5PM and will be one table with 14 players. Round will consist of a 30 minute open play window with a chip countdown at the end of 30 minutes. After the countdown, play will commence for 5 more minutes. The final score will be determined by the value of chips at the end of the round or the roll when an entrant has lost the last of their chips. If two entrants lose on the same roll, the amount of the line bet for the round will determine the place; the player who made the larger wager will place higher. 14 finalists will receive prize money according to the breakdown in the Tournament Payout Structure.

### Payout Structures

All prizes will be paid in cash or chips at winner's discretion

The Tournament Officials will handle any misdeal or dispute and their decision is final. These items are subject to change. In the unlikely event that there are not enough entrants, rounds may be cancelled. Meadows Casino has the right to change seating assignments in order to balance out the number of players at each table. Decisions of the Tournament Officials are final. Rules as presented in this document may change with prior approval by PGCB, however, the rules of the game may not be changed. Management may cancel, modify, relocate or reschedule the tournaments for any reason with prior approval by and/or notification to the appropriate gaming regulators. The Meadows Casino has the right to refuse play to anyone. House Rules will prevail on anything not covered by the above rules.

## CRAPS TOURNAMENT RULES

- Conversations should be limited and only casual in nature. Helping or advising other players is not permitted. If requested, there will be NO conversation during the final round.
- Coaching is not permitted during tournament play. No forms of verbal or visual communication will be permitted between tournament players and spectators.
- All players must remain at the table for the entire duration of each round. You will forfeit your score if you leave the table before your score is recorded.
- Smoking is not permitted in any round of the tournament.
- All rules for dealing Craps currently offered at The Meadows will be followed.
- You must keep your chips in plain view, separated by color. Refrain from shuffling or playing with chips.
- You may not have anything but tournament chips in front of you on the table, with the exception of drinks.
- Players cannot change their bets once it is booked or the dealer has moved to the next player.
- Every player must have a pass or don't pass line bet on every shooter and cannot be picked up after the come out roll.
- Commission will not be charged on buys or lays.
- No fire bets, whirl bets, horn high, horn low, hop bets or opposing bets will be permitted during tournament play.
- Every player must shoot when offered the dice, no passing.
- Do not stall the game. If a dealer or box person believes you are stalling, a tournament official will be called. If the tournament official believes you are stalling, the tournament official will give you 5 seconds to make your decision. If at the end of 5 seconds, you have not acted, the following will occur: If you have not made a wager, it automatically becomes the tournament minimum bet on the pass line.
- All disputes must be brought to the attention of the tournament official immediately and will be resolved prior to any player leaving the table.
- If you are late for the start of any round, you will be charged the tournament minimum bet per roll for the first 5 rolls. If you are not at the table by the start of the 6th roll, you will be disqualified.
- If it becomes necessary at any time to break a tie, the round scores will be recorded and then three additional rolls will occur, and repeated (if necessary), until the tie is broken. No additional chips received for tie breakers.
- Prize winners are responsible for paying all applicable taxes.
- Splitting of prize money on the final table is not allowed.
- You must be a member of the **mychoice** Rewards Program to participate in this tournament.
- Any players banned or excluded from The Meadows Racetrack and Casino are not eligible to participate.
- By participating in this tournament, you agree to abide by all tournament rules. If you are disqualified for any reason, you will not be eligible for a share in the prize money or a refund of any entry fee, when applicable.
- The Tournament will be directed/officiated by a Meadows Table Games Floor Supervisor or above.

The Tournament Officials will handle any mismarked points or disputes and their decision is final. These items are subject to change. Meadows Casino has the right to change seating assignments in order to balance out the number of players at each table. Decisions of the Tournament Officials are final. Rules are subject to change at the discretion of management. Management may cancel, modify, relocate or reschedule the tournaments for any reason with prior approval by and/or notification to the appropriate gaming regulators. The Meadows Casino has the right to refuse play to anyone. House Rules will prevail on anything not covered by the above rules.
